Required Agreement for Membership

EMACHE shall be composed of home educating families who desire to affiliate. By joining EMACHE, member families agree to operate their home schools in accordance with the Statement of Principles (Article VIII) and the Confession of Faith (Article IX), and agree to abide by this Constitution. Failure to comply with this provision shall be grounds for dismissal from membership.

- 1. Membership and P.E. dues are nonrefundable and will be exacted per family and will be determined each year by the officers with the approval of the membership in regular business meetings. Special provision will be made for those who desire to be members, but are unable to pay.
2. Those who cease to abide by the Constitution, or who otherwise bring disrepute on the Association shall be biblically confronted by the officers of the Association for restoration and, if necessary, will be removed from membership by unanimous consent of the officers (Matthew 18: 15-20; 2 John 9-11; I Corinthians 5:1-5).
3. I hereby agree to my child's participation in any and all of the Physical Education activities sponsored by EMACHE. With regard to Physical Education and all other EMACHE activities, I further waive any and all claims for myself and my children against EMACHE, the leaders of EMACHE, including the instructors of P.E. I also waive any and all claims against the facilities used by EMACHE. In the event of an emergency, the instructor has my permission to obtain medical treatment for the child at the nearest hospital or doctor at my expense.

I agree to abide by the EMACHE Constitution or withdraw from membership. I understand that unless I am a first-year member I am expected to volunteer to coordinate or assist in some activity or function. The above information will be published in the EMACHE Directory for use by its members only. Failure to fulfill one's duties may result in rejection of next year's application.

PE EMACHE DRESS CODE

NOTE: All members must sign (so that we don't have to remember to come back to this if they change their mind).

The following guidelines are presented to prevent inappropriate attire, and for safety precautions. It is important to encourage your children to be respectful in the way they dress and to be an example accordingly. Remember that clothes often reveal the character of a Christian.

The following guidelines apply to children and parents alike.

1. No skin-tight shirts and shorts. E.g., no Spandex, "skinny jeans", or similar.
2. Shorts
 - No short shorts. E.g., no short runner shorts, competition volleyball shorts, or similar.
 - Inseams shall be six inches minimum.
 - Under garments shall not be visible, neither in standing, nor sitting.
3. Girls Shirts
 - No sleeveless, or low cut V-neck, tank-tops, or loose-scooped neck shirts.
 - No tight fitting workout clothing.
 - Collars shall be approximately three fingers down from the base of the neck.
 - Shirts shall be long enough to completely cover the midriff, even when un-tucked during normal PE activities.
 - T-shirts are good.
4. Boys Shirts
 - No muscle t-shirts or sleeveless shirts.
 - Shirts shall be long enough to completely cover the midriff, even when un-tucked during normal PE activities.
 - T-shirts are good.
5. No slogans that can be interpreted to be inappropriate, e.g., double entendre, or otherwise conveying innuendo, violence, immoral behaviors, gaming, skulls, and the like.
6. Shoes - For your child's safety, no open toed shoes, sandals, flip-flops, crocs, backless footwear, boots, or shoes with heels are to be worn to PE. Any child wearing these types of shoes might not be permitted to participate in PE that day.

It is the parent's responsibility for the attire of their children. If you are unsure of any of the guidelines, please feel free to contact the PE Coordinator privately.

Dress to not lead astray, nor distract (for self-gratification or not, knowingly or unknowingly). Dress modestly, decently, and soberly to reflect Christian values.
